I would like to express my appreciation to all members of the Toyota Industries Group for your efforts in actively undertaking environmental activities on a daily basis.

Since formulating the First Environmental Action Plan in 1993, we have proactively engaged in environmental initiatives. In FY2021, the final year of the Sixth Environmental Action Plan, we faced such extreme weather events as unprecedentedly intense heat, storms and other natural disasters in addition to the impact of COVID-19. Despite such harsh conditions, we successfully achieved targets specified in each action item. These achievements were made possible by your steady efforts, including daily energy-saving activities and preventive actions against environmental incidents.

Currently, countries around the world are working toward realizing a carbon-neutral society by setting up ambitious environmental goals. Likewise, the Japanese government has announced such specific numerical targets as a 46% reduction* of greenhouse gases in 2030 and carbon neutrality in 2050.

Toyota Industries has recently announced the **Seventh Environmental Action Plan**, which includes action items to contribute to realizing a carbon neutral society. Specifically, we will aim for **ambitious targets of reducing* CO₂ emissions by 35% by FY2026 and in half by FY2031**.

We all must do our part in ongoing, steady environmental activities at our respective workplaces, including energy-saving efforts.
